1. Welcome and introductions. Sarah Dillivan-Pospisil volunteered to take minutes
2. Approval of August minutes- Motion to approve Augusta minutes by Bernklau, Piñero seconded, motion passed
3. Updates
 - a) Alliance for Substance Abuse Prevention – *Piñero*:
 1. The Students Against Destructive Decisions (SADD) Advisors meet, August 7th at the Health Department to plan the annual student training. This year’s training will be held October 25th, at the Lismore. There will be breakout sessions ranging in topics from Anxiety, Stress, and Your Mental Health to What’s a Compliance Check. Tom Kidd is confirmed to be the keynote speaker.
 2. The Alliance is working to get there name out to the community. They attended the National Night Out in Altoona and Eau Claire but were rained out in Altoona. ASAP is working to purchase a tablecloth and tent to attend future events
 3. Communication and Policies and Practices workgroups are continuing to meet. Communication is generating a social media and marketing campaign. Policies and Practices is continuing to work on the November Advisory Referendum regarding marijuana. Prevention efforts are still the primary focus of the Alliance and they will continue to provide education around the topic
 - b) Alcohol Environment – *Weber*:
 1. Six alcohol detox occurred over the weekend
 2. Bars collecting fake ID from those under 21 trying to buy alcohol
 1. Law enforcement continues to work with the bars to collect IDs and track how many are collected through the year
 - c) Chamber Workplace Wellness Learning Circle- August 16 – *Eddy*
 1. Presentation on low risk and Alcohol Screening and Brief Intervention provided to approximately 17 participants

- d) Alcohol policy seminar training– *Wilson*
 - 1. Sessions are specialized for local officials, law enforcement, coalition leaders, and advocates focusing on evidence-based policies, practices and their enforcement to prevent and reduce excessive alcohol use
 - 2. October 10, 9:00am – 4:00pm in Wisconsin Dells- if anyone is interested in attending let Sarah know
 - 3. Registration fee \$125.00 covers all sessions, materials and meals
 - 1. Registration fee waiver may be available

 - b) Review Goals & Objectives
 - 1. Goal 1: Increase responsible use of alcohol consumption in Eau Claire County through awareness, education, collaboration, and policy change.
 - Objective 1: By 2021, increased awareness of alcohol best practices with at least two community events.
 - Objective 2: By 2021, decrease high-risk drinking behaviors among youth and adults by developing three community-based policies, practices, ordinances and/or codes related to alcohol use.
 - Objective 3: By 2021, Complete at least two cross-collaboration efforts with other coalitions/action teams to increase awareness of the connection between alcohol use/chronic disease/mental health.

 - 1. Draft CHIP Action Plan/ Revise goals/objects
